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## 1. Program Overview

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The Team Tenacious Summer Internship Program is an intensive, 8-week experiential learning initiative designed to equip young people with transformational life skills, leadership principles, and financial intelligence. Participants engage in structured coaching sessions, a curated reading curriculum with personal takeaway presentations, and — for eligible students — real-world financial services business experience through HGI (Hegemon Group International) and the AI-powered platform BuilderPath.ai.

This program is built on the conviction that the most important education a young person can receive is the education they cannot get in a traditional classroom: how to think, communicate, lead, and build lasting financial freedom.

**Program Mission:** To inspire and equip the next generation of leaders by immersing them in

world-class books, proven leadership systems, AI-driven business tools, and real-world

earning opportunities — all within a structured, coach-supported environment.

## 2. Program Tracks

The program offers two distinct tracks based on age and eligibility. Each track is thoughtfully designed to meet participants where they are and take them further than they imagined.

## 3. Session Schedule

### Recurring Coaching Sessions

Coaches will conduct two live sessions per week for each track throughout the 8-week program. Sessions are interactive and structured to maximize learning, accountability, and collaboration.

## What Happens During Sessions

- **Book Takeaway Presentations:** Each student shares their key insights and concrete commitments from the assigned reading — starting from Day 1.
- **Leadership Coaching:** Using the Leadership Format System and BuilderPath.ai platform, coaches guide students in developing leadership habits and business acumen.
- **Peer Collaboration:** Students learn from each other's perspectives, building communication skills, critical thinking, and professional confidence.
- **Business Activity Review (Young Professionals):** Coaches review meeting-scheduling progress, recruits, and sales performance against each student's HGI account.

## 4. Reading Curriculum

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*Each book is assigned for a specific week. Students are expected to read the book, prepare a written summary of personal takeaways, and present what they will implement in their own life. Presentations begin from Day 1 of the program.*

**Note:** The Leadership Format System book (Week 1) is assigned to the Young Professionals

Track (ages 18–25) only. All other books are required for both tracks.

## Presentation Expectations

- Each student prepares a brief but substantive written summary of personal takeaways from each book.
- Students present to the group during scheduled sessions: What did you learn? What will you implement? How will it change your life?
- Coaches will provide feedback and guide the student toward concrete action steps.
- Quality of reflection and commitment to implementation is more important than volume.

## 5. Technology Platform: BuilderPath.ai

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All participants will be introduced to and trained on **BuilderPath.ai**, an AI-powered business growth platform developed to help financial services professionals grow faster and more efficiently. Features include:

- AI-assisted prospecting and meeting scheduling tools
- Performance tracking and business volume reporting
- Learning modules for leadership and financial literacy
- Mentor and coach connectivity

BuilderPath.ai accelerates each student's ability to practice and apply what they learn in real time, making it a central tool throughout the internship experience.

## 6. Compensation and Earnings

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**Important: There is no cap on earnings. Every student has equal opportunity to**

**maximize their income through hustle, skill, and consistency.**

### All Participants

- **\$20.00** for every successful meeting scheduled — unlimited.
- Earnings are credited directly to the student's account in the system.

### Young Professionals Track (Ages 18–25) — Additional Earnings

- All recruits and sales are logged in the student's personal HGI account.
- Business volume and cash flow accrue per the HGI Builder Compensation Plan.

- Students learn to build and manage their own financial services business from the ground up.

### Young Professionals — Enrollment Requirements

1. Enroll as a Team Tenacious partner: **\$199 enrollment fee.**
2. Obtain HGI license **on or before August 7, 2026** (end of internship).
3. Our team will provide full guidance and support through the licensing process.

## 7. What Students Will Gain

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Skill Area	Description
<b>Leadership</b>	Practical leadership principles taught through the Leadership Format System and world-class books
<b>Financial Intelligence</b>	Understanding of money, investment, wealth building, and financial services through books and real-world practice
<b>Communication</b>	Public speaking, persuasion, active listening, and professional presence — applied daily
<b>Business Acumen</b>	How businesses are built, how compensation plans work, and how to create recurring income
<b>Technology Fluency</b>	Hands-on experience with AI business tools via BuilderPath.ai
<b>Personal Development</b>	Self-awareness, goal-setting, discipline, and the habits of high-performers through transformational reading
<b>Professional Network</b>	Relationships with coaches, mentors, partners, and fellow interns that extend beyond the program

## 8. Parent and Guardian Information

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Parents and guardians of Young Leaders Track (ages 14–17) participants play an important role in this program's success:

- Parents must be current Team Tenacious partners or clients for their child to be eligible.
- Parents are encouraged to read along with their children and discuss the books at home.
- At least one parent or guardian contact (name, email, phone) is required on the application form.
- Parents will receive periodic updates on their child's progress from program coaches.

## 9. Application Process

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1. **Scan the QR code** on the flyer or visit the application link to access the online form.
2. **Complete the application form** — student details, contact information, parent/guardian information, and a brief personal statement.
3. **Our team reviews your application** and follows up within 48 hours via email or phone.
4. **Enrollment is confirmed** and you receive your welcome packet, session links, and book list.
5. **Young Professionals:** Complete the \$199 partner enrollment and begin the HGI licensing process with guidance from our team.

*Spots are limited. We encourage interested students and their families to apply early.*
